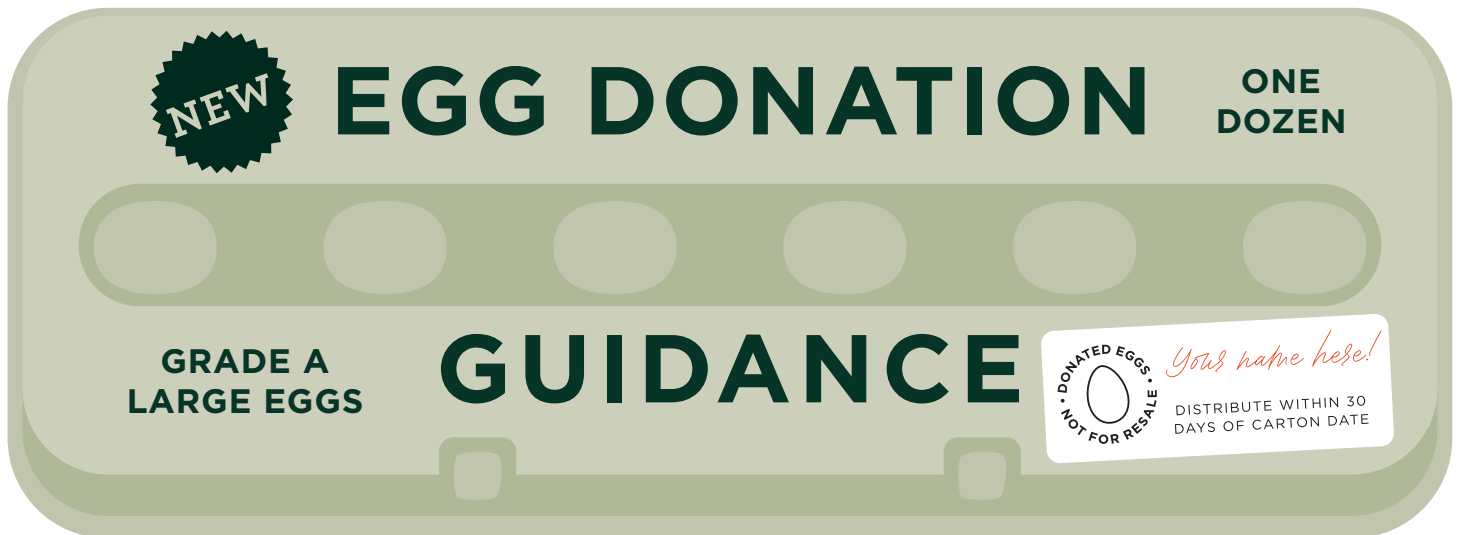




Beginning August 1, 2026,
retailers can donate eggs
to charitable food programs
30 days after their quality
assurance date.

EGGS MUST BE:

- In original packaging
- From a retailer
- Continuously refrigerated
- Not more than 30 days past date
on carton (quality assurance date)

FOOD PROGRAMS MUST:

- Put a new label on eggs received
past quality assurance date
- Discard eggs that are 30 days or
more past quality assurance date

LABELS MUST CONTAIN THE FOLLOWING INFORMATION:

- Name of distributing food shelf
- "Donated eggs; not for resale"
- "Distribute within 30 days of
carton date"
